With direct democracy, the people take decisions themselves (e.g. show of hands at a public meeting) or referendums. The UK doesn't use referendums as much as some other countries. The last one was the Scottish Independence referendum, and the next will be a referendum on EU membership in 2017. In the UK, the government calls the referendum, but in some countries, such as Switzerland and the USA, the people can trigger a referendum by way of petition, which is called an initiative.
