Subtlety and simplicity characterises his work within this medium. Publisher Johannes Froben commissioned Hans Holbein the Younger to produce multiple illustrations for several upcoming books by Sir Thomas More and Desiderius Erasmus. This was one of the highest profile commissions that he received for his work as a draughtsman.
