I really felt astonished by this little island, so close to Malaysia and Indonesia.As the neighboring countries seem to struggle against poverty, a relative under-development or corruption, Singapore is growing fast and succeeding. FOR MORE THAN THREE DECADES, Soeharto reigned as the most powerful man in Indonesia - President, father figure and infallible leader to millions. He co-founded the Centre for Strategic and International Studies in 1971 and amongst his many other responsibilities and appointments he currently serves as President Director of "The Jakarta Post" and Chairman of Prasetya Mulya Business School.
